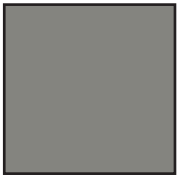

Square



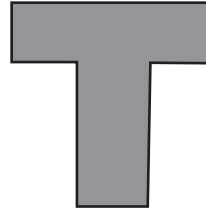
Rectangle



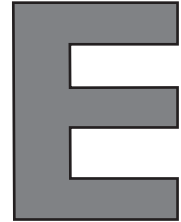
"L" Shape

"E", "F" and "U" Shape

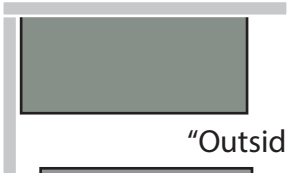

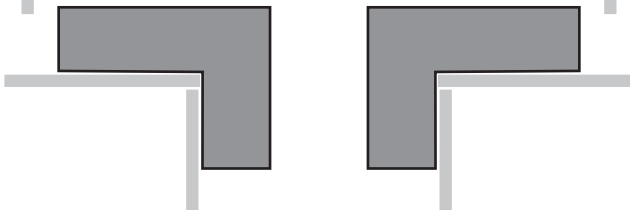


Position in Room or Shed

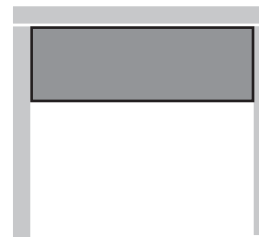
"Inside" Corner



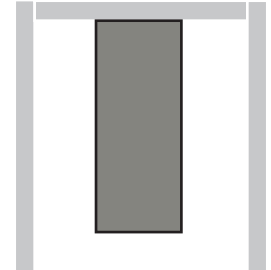
"Outside" Corner

Room or Shed Dimensions and Shape



The accurate description of your available space or base board shape is the starting point for the design of your new layout. Examine the drawings above to identify the base board shape, room or shed space that best fits your circumstances.

To complete the description

of working area for your plan, measure all straight lines (m or mm). Include all dimensions along walls, around corners and precisely locate (by measuring) access points: doors, stairs, floor length windows etc. Drawings and photos are helpful.

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
